Huntington Public Library welcomes four young artists nominated by the Art Department of Huntington High School for this exhibit.

The Fine Arts play a significant role in the educational program in the Huntington Schools. From Kindergarten through their high school years, students create original art work in a wide variety of media. Skill-based instruction in contour drawing, value, light shading, color theory, perspective, two-dimensional and three-dimensional design is provided sequentially throughout the grades.

High School students have the opportunity to take advanced studies in drawing and painting, ceramics and sculpture, and fashion design, as well as technology-based programs such as computer graphics, advertising and design, media arts, video, photography and animation. High School seniors may participate in career internships in all areas of the visual arts. Fifth Grade and High School students participate annually in the Heckscher Museum's Docent Program.

Huntington students' art work is proudly displayed at the yearly District-Wide Art Show on view during the annual budget vote. Student art work is frequently displayed and honored in local exhibits and competitions. Huntington also takes great pride in exhibiting student's work in the new High School "Blue Room" art gallery and on the District's website.
