“SICILIAN JOURNEY”

Sicilian Journey traces the artist’s travels through Sicily over a period of several years. As a photojournalist, Janine Coyne documents the humanity of Sicily – the small villages, people living their lives in simplicity and the remains of antiquity. Janine initially began this journey to learn more about her paternal grandparents who lived on the Aeolian Island of Stromboli. She chooses black and white as her medium and hand prints her photographs. Janine combines the fine art qualities of light, tonality and strong composition to enhance her images.

Sicilian Journey has been the subject of solo exhibitions at the Italian American Museum in New York and the Riverside Museum in California. Her photographs are included in the permanent collections of The Brooklyn Museum, The Museum of The City of New York and The National Museum of Immigration of Ellis Island. Janine Coyne is a professor at Kingsborough Community College and The College of Staten Island of The City University of New York where she teaches photography.
