Carol and Richard have won prizes in a number of juried competitions around Long Island, and several of their photographs have appeared in Newsday. They have photographs which have been exhibited at the Atrium Gallery of the Huntington Arts Council, the Suffolk YJCC, and in several Long Island libraries.

In addition to their exhibits of photographic prints, they have produced digital multi-media DVD-based shows of their travels through Asia, Africa and South America. These shows have been presented at a number of libraries, at The Stony Brook University Round Table, and at the Huntington Camera Club.

For over 25 years they have been members (Master Level) of the Huntington Camera Club. Richard is a past President of the Huntington Camera Club, and more than once he has won their Photographer of the Year award. He is also an Artist Member of the Huntington Arts Council. Carole is now retired and was a Special Ed teacher. Richard was a physicist at Brookhaven National Lab.
