Kathryn Heuzey, a native Long Islander, has lived and raised her family in the Huntington area for the last twenty years.

Ms. Heuzey’s work is most inspired by an art movement known as “Contemporary Naturalism” – American artists in the 60’s and 70’s who rendered subjects from contemporary life in a representational manner, but a fresh and modern style.

Her work reflects her life here on Long Island – the landscapes, people and objects that are part of the fabric of everyday life. She is drawn to the complexity and richness of form, color, detail and texture found in nature and objects. She is grateful to be living in such a beautiful area.

Ms. Heuzey holds a B.S. in Studio Art from Skidmore College and an M.A. in Art Therapy from New York University. She has studied painting and drawing at the Tyler School of Art in Rome, Italy, and with Schilli Maier. Ms. Heuzey teaches art at Continuing Education programs in the Roslyn and Cold Spring Harbor school districts, and has been a consultant for special programs in those districts.

Ms. Heuzey is currently represented by Peconic Bay Originals in Woodbury, NY, Grand Image in Seattle, Washington and the B.J. Spoke Gallery in Huntington.
